

Homework: Get to Know Your Team

The Task: Become familiar with key information about the countries on your FGP Team.

Standard: **9.3.1.1.1** – Create tables, graphs, charts, diagrams and various kinds of maps including: symbol, dot and choropleth maps to depict the geographic implications of current world events or to solve geographic problems.

How To:

1. Use CIA World Factbook or any other sources listed on www.fanschool.us under Resources.
2. Create a map on ArcGIS Online that you will continue to add to all trimester.
3. Add a “Map Note” for each country you drafted. For each general country map note you will add 5 pins for each.
4. The 5 pins for each country’s map note will include:
 - a. Country name and economy level
 - i. Text type of map note is recommended
 - b. Capital which includes the leader’s name, and a definition of the type of government
 - i. Capital name as title of note, leader name and government type in description
 - c. A location of historical importance – include an explanation
 - d. A current issue within the country
 - e. A current issue with another country
5. Share the map to the class group when complete. Name the map FGP_YOURNAME.
6. You will continue to add to this map all trimester.
7. If you drop a country throughout the trimester, edit the country name and put in the date dropped. Add the name of the added country and include the date picked up. You DO NOT have to go back and do all of the previous assignments for the new country.

Grading: Homework – 20 points

1. Accuracy and Completeness (8 points)
 - a. All components of the assignment are complete with the expected information.
 - b. All Information provided is correct.
2. Effort and Thought (8 points)
 - a. Work demonstrates consideration and thorough understanding of the information.
 - b. Assignment shows effort and creativity (when appropriate)

 - b. Assignment is neat and looks nice.
